 - Please be respectful with noise during and after the event, and ensure cars are parked appropriately.
 - All parents/carers are required to sign the 'sign-in register' on behalf of their child/ren for insurance purposes. All participants must have registered with the school via permission form prior to the event.



Thank you to Ms Wills (aka Miss Brett) for accompanying the students during the proceedings.

Keep up the fantastic efforts with the Premiers Reading Challenge. Reading is an essential tool that will stay with students for the remainder of their lives throughout not only educational settings but also

As mentioned earlier in the year, the NSW Department of Education is focusing on student attendance/absenteeism in 2024 more so than in previous years. Principals, teaching and non-teaching staff all have individual responsibilities and play a significant role in supporting parents to ensure their child/ren attend school every day. The everyday matters campaign is designed to highlight the importance of student attendance and engagement in their key learning areas, along with relevant social involvement within their peer groups. Not only is it desirable & beneficial, it is also a legal requirement for all students younger than 16, to attend their enrolled education setting every school day unless sick or unwell. It is then the parent/carer responsibility to contact the school to provide explanation of absence. I ask that you either telephone the school or use the parent portal as soon as you are aware that your child/ren will be absent. Thank you in advance for your support in this vitally important matter.

The parent portal is now up and running and waiting for you to register. Ms Crocker has sent out communication and instructions on how to register online. The parent portal and mobile app are supported and recommended by the NSW Department of Education and are becoming very popular with parents. The platform is very simple and user friendly to make payments, give permission for excursions and events, and notify of student absences. Student statement of accounts are now due and are available for payment through the student portal. If you are experiencing hardship and would like to enter a payment plan you are more than welcome to do so, please contact the office for further information.

All volunteers assisting with setting up, please meet at the sporting fields at 1pm.


