### The Premier's Challenges are up and running!

The **Premier's Sporting challenge** again this year involves both students and teachers. Our challenge is to reach goals relating to a range of fitness activities, including push ups, wall sits, skipping etc. We have all started at our own personal ability level and are building from there. The Years 3 to 6 students are also recording the number of minutes a week they participate in physical activity at school and at home. It's great fun to push ourselves whilst becoming fitter. The challenge runs for all of Term 2.

### It is time, again, for the **Premier's Spelling Bee Challenge!**

This year, interested students will be encouraged to go online to practise spelling the words on the 2019 list at home. Their progress will be monitored and encouraged at school. Two students from Years 3 and 4 as well as two students from Years 5 and 6, will go forward to the regional finals sometime between 2nd to 13th September (Week 7 and 8), during Term 3.

Meanwhile, go to the website,

<https://www.artsunit.nsw.edu.au/premiers-spelling-bee> and select either the '2019 Junior Simple Word List' (Year 3&4) or '2019 Senior Simple word List' (Year 5&6). Once you have clicked on the list, you will be asked for your password, which is: 'pizza'. There are also annotated word lists available on the same page as the simple word lists, that give word definitions. However, students are not tested on meanings, only spelling.

Please encourage your children to participate. It is a great extension opportunity for keen spellers!

The **Premiers Reading Challenge** is now well underway and it is pleasing to see a number of students already on their way to meeting the challenge.

All students are encouraged to participate by regularly reading quality books at home. For all of the instructions and information head to the PRC website ([www.premiersreadingchallenge.nsw.edu.au](http://www.premiersreadingchallenge.nsw.edu.au)).

Students can click onto the "logon" tab and enter their school username and password. If you are unsure of your password or you do not have access to the internet at home, please see Mrs Mason. Here are a few important points.

- 1. You must complete your online Student Reading Record by 30<sup>th</sup> August 2019 to complete the Challenge and this is a home based activity.**
- 2. You must read a certain number of books to complete the Challenge.**
- 3. If you complete your online Student Reading Record you will be eligible for a PRC certificate.**
