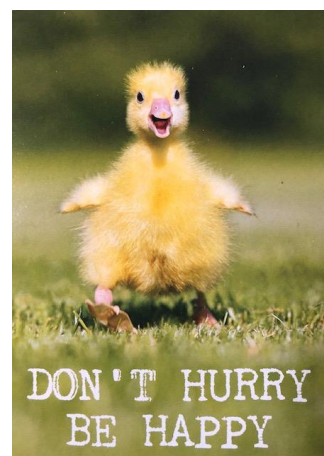

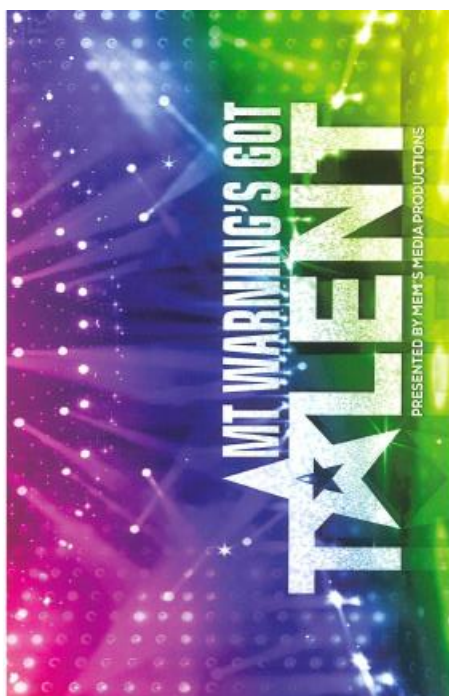

DRESS REHEARSAL/MATINEE PERFORMANCE:
