We are all still enjoying the beautiful weather. We are halfway through the term already...

Today was our last day of Kindy 2021 orientation – how fast did that go! As you can see from the front page, our students and the pre-schoolers have had a wonderful time. Thank you to those who came along to the parent orientation morning this morning. We look forward to seeing you all again at the beginning of 2021. Thank you also to the P&C for providing morning tea.

Thank you to those who came along to today's P&C meeting. The main discussion centered on the end of year activities. It has been decided that we will postpone (not cancel) the Christmas Carols until December **2021**. We will still be having the Christmas Hamper raffle – it will be drawn on Presentation Day. We ask that all families send in donations towards the hampers (NO toys please). Tickets will be attached to next week's newsletter.

Next **Thursday 19 November** all the students and staff will be involved in a water fun day. The students will work their way through a tabloid of crazy water activities and will definitely get wet. Students are to arrive at school in their full school uniforms with their usual bags packed. They will also need to bring their **swimmers, a sun-safe shirt, towel, shoes suitable for water play (like creek shoes or crocs, NO thongs) and a water proof bag for wet clothes**.
