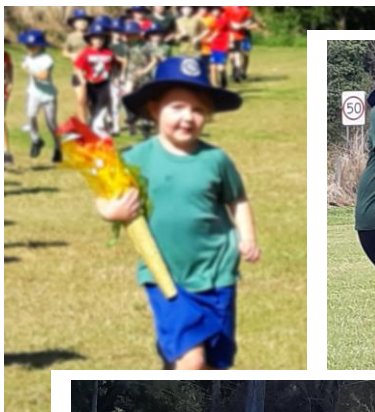

## From the Principal's Desk

And the term is done! The weather is just perfect for the holidays... I hope you all take the time to rest, recoup and start the new term with renewed vigor.

Thank you again to all those who have kept their child/ren home when they haven't been feeling well. It has worked very effectively in stopping the spread of colds in the school. Please remember next term is FLU season and we are aiming for zero ('flat curve') if possible.

We had a fantastic day yesterday at the sporting fields and at school. It was a great way to end the term for both teachers, students and parents. The students were involved in relays and fun sporting events. It was also a great way to say thank you and good bye to Mr Bloomfield and Mrs Bergquist who finish this week. Mr Prestwich will continue here but only two days a week. Thank you to all the teachers for putting the day together.

I have been approached by a few parents with concerns regarding the afternoon pick-ups and the safety of the children in the carpark. 
