Sidney Nolan comes to Chillingham!

The Year 3,4,5 and 6 students have just completed a collage in response to studying the Australian artist Sidney Nolan's paintings: the Ned Kelly Series.

During their artmaking, students learnt about the story of Ned Kelly and studied and practised some of the features of Sidney Nolan's painting such as: using simple, black shapes for armour, using golds and blues to convey 'outback' landscape and creating emotionally expressive landscapes, gestures and eyes to express Kelly's different moods. Students also practised drawing techniques and working with mixed media. They were all pretty pleased with their final artwork.


