Our Graduation and Awards Ceremony will be held on **Wednesday 8 December**, starting at 10am. Santa will be making an appearance and distributing presents. The Department of Education, in line with the Public Health Orders for NSW, has placed strict conditions on any and all activities taking place on school sites. As such:

All schools wishing to conduct graduation ceremonies must follow the current COVID-safe plan.

- ensure it is held outside
- ensure that all attendees including students and staff and visitors are well and free of any flu-like symptoms and have not been directed to self-isolate by NSW Health.
- all external visitors to the school site, including parents and invited guests must show evidence of full vaccination.
- only fully vaccinated parents, carers and guests can attend, and as long as the space complies with the current square metre rule within the COVID-19 Safety Plan.
- ensure people remain seated as much as possible to minimise mingling outside of non-household groups or close friend groups.
- staff and visitors attending the graduation are required to sign in using the venue's QR code checkin process. A digitised record of name and a contact number for those who are unable to check in using the QR code must be kept for a period of at least 28 days.
- visitors should not be allowed access to areas outside of the designated event venue and should leave promptly at the conclusion of the event.

You are welcome to bring your own morning tea, but we are unable to provide any kind of buffet.

The Christmas Hamper raffle will be drawn on this day (8 December). Please start to send in donations (No toys please). Tickets will be attached to the next Newsletter.

School accounts need to be paid before **Friday 3 December**. If you are having financial difficulties please contact the school so we can best assist you.


