

A pilot program is being offered to provide training and in-school office experience in Terms 3 and 4 2022 with the potential for ongoing employment in local Tweed Coast and Wollumbin network schools in 2023.

About the role

Expressions of Interest are being called for community members interested in receiving on-the job office administration training at various public schools in the Tweed Coast and Wollumbin network area. This pilot program will provide guaranteed 2 days per week temporary employment while receiving on the job training in school administrative procedures and Department of Education systems for 20 weeks, beginning August 2022. The rate of pay will be as per School Admin Officer (SAO) rate of \$222.37 per day.

The minimum 40 days on the job training and employment will include onboarding processes, specific training in a small group training facility provided by an experienced School Administrative Manager and hands-on experience in a local school office environment.

Role criteria

1. Excellent oral and written communication and customer service skills to liaise with students, parents, staff and community members
 2. Ability to work as part of an effective, highly organised administration team
 3. Demonstrated capacity to meet deadlines, show initiative, multi-task and prioritise work in a busy office environment
- Willingness to learn how to use Department of Education systems

Who can apply?

Applications are invited from community members who are interested in working in a school office and believe they can learn the skills required – regardless of whether they are currently working or not. All participants will be required to provide or apply for a working with children check (WWCC) as a part of the onboarding process.
