The students from years 3 to 6 took part in a "Blind Cricket" match on Tuesday with Mrs Sandercock and Mr Newton. The aim of the match was to allow students to experience what it would be like for those who experience vision impairment. The students had to try and hit the cricket ball, which had a noise maker (metal screws) inserted whilst being blindfolded or wearing vision impairing glasses. Everyone enjoyed themselves and by the end of the time were able to actually hit the ball using their ear senses! Blind cricket is played throughout Australia by people with a vision impaired disability.

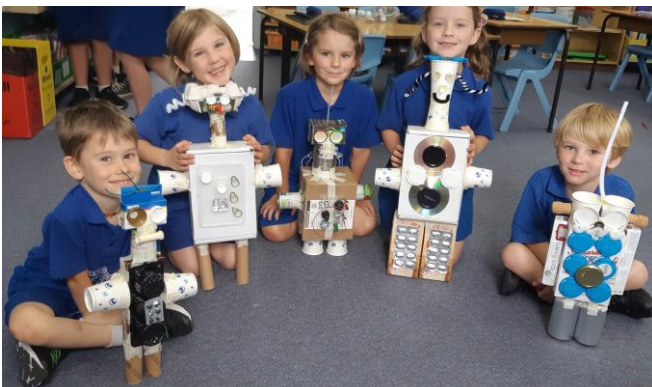

## ROBOTS Cross-curriculum

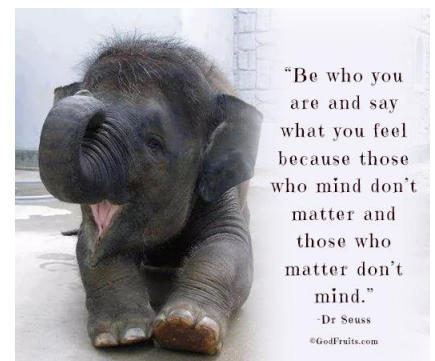
