Building positive attendance habits ~ What you can do.

You can help build positive attendance habits by:

- Helping your child learn the importance of punctuality and routine.
- Making sure your child arrives on time from the start of the school day, ready to take part.
- Reducing disruption to learning where you can, by planning any necessary appointments outside of school time.
- Contact the school to explain any absences (within 7 days of the first day of absence).
- Making sure any holidays or medical appointments are taken outside of school hours.
- Work with the school to encourage and support regular attendance.

Reasons for missing school ~ Being absent, late or leaving early.

- If your child misses school for any reason, please contact the school within 7 days to explain why.
- If your child needs to arrive late or leave early, please notify the school.
- If you have difficulty getting your child to school on time every day, please also contact the school. School staff are here to support you and your child to help them come to school each day.
