Backing our Furies

The community came out in force last Friday to support our Furies. Local Rural Fire Service members shared lifesaving information, given the current catastrophic bushfire season. Supported by other emergency services (SES and Red Cross), the community was brought up to speed on the local situation and preparations. Questions from the audience were answered and names gathered to set up support networks; neighbours helping neighbours.

The two information packs provide a 4 step guide for a bushfire survival plan, should we encounter bushfires in our community. The packs detailed essential information to safeguard your family. Very briefly:

- Make a family plan – what to pack
- Prepare your home or property
- Know the bushfire alert levels
- Keep up to date with information
- Move pets and leave early

Tweed Shire Council now has an Emergency Dashboard (bottom right hand corner of the home page) with up to date information and links to all services.
