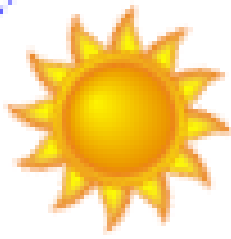
The school Christmas raffles will be drawn after the carols. Tickets will be available to purchase throughout the evening.

The evening will be hosted by Tracey Rosser, P&C President and Ms Vicki Roach, School Principal.

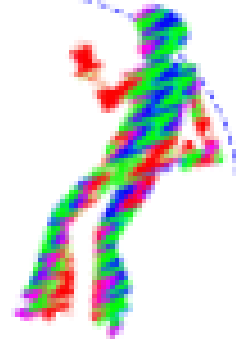
All you need to do is bring your rug or chair, some coins for drinks and slushies, along with your best singing voice and your festive spirit.
